JUROR: **James Grashow** is a noted sculptor and printmaker who has been creating works that address themes of man, nature and mortality since the 1960's. His sculptures of paper and corrugated cardboard range from large environmental installations to delicate, self-contained 'worlds'. Also a well-known woodcut artist, his prints have appeared regularly in the New York Times and almost every other publication in the U.S. Mr. Grashow studied painting and sculpture at Pratt Institute, receiving his MFA in 1965. He has taught at Pratt, the Parsons School of Design, and Fairfield University. He currently teaches workshops at the Marie Walsh Sharpe Art Foundation in Colorado and other venues. His home and studio are in Connecticut. His work has been exhibited at the Whitney Museum, the Aldrich Museum, the New Britain Museum of American Art, the Roanoke Museum of Fine Art, and the DeCordova Museum, among many others. He has received numerous awards and honors. Commissions include Morgan Stanley, Walt Disney, MOMA, the New York Public Library and the Staten Island Children's Museum. Mr. Grashow has been represented by the Allan Stone Gallery in New York since 1966.

PRIZES: \$500 Best in Show and other cash prizes.

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS: This exhibition is

open to all area artists and NCSA members. A maximum of two works per artist will be accepted for a non-refundable jurying fee of \$15 for one and \$25 for two entries for NCSA members; \$20 for one and \$35 for two entries for non-members. Entry card and fee should be presented with works. All entries must have been completed within the past two years and may not have been previously exhibited at the Carriage Barn.

MEDIA SPECIFICATIONS: Acceptable media: oil, watercolor, acrylic, pastel, drawings, graphics, mixed media and sculpture. No photography. Original work only. Slides will not be considered. Two dimensional works must not exceed 50" wide and must be securely framed and wired for hanging. Sculpture must be small enough for two people to handle comfortably and not exceed 100 lbs. All sculpture must be delivered fully assembled and be presented in a permanent, non-fragile medium. If your sculpture requires a pedestal, you must provide one that is acceptable to NCSA. LIABILITY AND INSURANCE: Insurance covers work accepted for exhibition while in possession of NCSA. NCSA will insure all accepted work to the extent of 70% of the value accepted by the insurance company less any deductible. NCSA

will not be liable for work not claimed after specified pick-up dates and times.

SALES: NCSA receives a 30% donation on sales.

RECEIVING: All work must be hand delivered to the Carriage Barn Arts Center on Tuesday, April 15, between the hours of 10:00 am and 2:00 pm and evening hours between 6:30 pm and 8:00 pm. Do NOT ship or mail work.

PICK-UP: Removal of work not accepted will be Monday, April 21, from 10:00 am to 2:00 pm and 6:30 pm to 8:00 pm. Pick-up of accepted work will be Monday, June 16, from 10:00 am to 2:00 pm and 6:30 pm to 8:00 pm.

OPENING RECEPTION: The opening reception will be held Sunday, April 27, from 4:00 pm to 6:00 pm. Prizes will be presented at 5:00 pm.

Exhibition dates: April 27 – June 15, 2008
Please note the gallery will be **closed Sunday, May 4th** for a Waveny Chamber Concert.

Gallery Hours: Tuesday through Friday, 12:00 pm to 4:00 pm; Saturday and Sunday, 1:00 pm to 5:00 pm. (except Sunday, May 4th)

DIRECTIONS: Entrance to Waveny Park is on Route 124 (South Ave.), 1/4 mile north of the Merritt Parkway - Exit 37.
